### Recipe of the month

#### Buckshot’s quick ‘n easy Peach cake

2 cans sliced or diced peaches  
1 yellow cake mix  
1 can lemon-lime soda  
1 12 inch Dutch Oven

Drain the peaches, reserving the juice in case you need more liquid. If peaches are not diced break them up into smaller pieces. Place in dutch oven.

Open cake mix and pour in oven. (Yes dry.)

Open soda and pour into oven. Mix it all together with spoon. If it appears that more liquid is needed you can add some peach juice drained earlier.

Bake for 45-60 mins using 12 briquettes on top and 12 on the bottom checking and rotating oven every 15minutes to prevent burning.

Serve with ice cream or your favorite whipped topping!
